Mass Plantation Awareness and Tree Plantation Campaign

On the auspicious occasion of World Environment Day, **June 5**, we are launching a grand initiative, a Polythene-Free Awareness Campaign. Following this, from **June 5 to July 15, 2026**, a **statewide awareness campaign** will be conducted, and then a **plantation drive** will be conducted from **July 16, 2026**, to **August 15, 2026**

Objective of the Campaign:

- To raise awareness among every citizen about environmental conservation and greenery.
- To make Uttarakhand a green state through tree plantation across schools, colleges, government and non-government offices, parks, and housing societies.
- To promote a love for nature among children, youth, and the general public.

Key Activities:

- **'Donate a Plant' Drive** — A "Donate a Plant" Drive will be conducted in schools and colleges to encourage the donation of plants.
- **Tree Plantation Programs** — The collected plants will be planted with the help of partner organizations, societies, and in public spaces.
- **Workshops, Essay & Painting Competitions** — To be organized at school and college levels on the theme of environmental awareness.
- **Polythene-Free Campaign** — Through the public awareness campaign, awareness will be raised about the harmful effects of polythene and the use of cloth and jute bags will be encouraged.
- **Training on Plant Care** — To teach proper care techniques and highlight the importance of plants.

Special Appeal:

We will also appeal to the Hon'ble Chief Minister and the Government of Uttarakhand to reimagine the Harela Festival (16th July) not as a holiday, but as a day of Statewide Environmental Action, much like how Republic Day and Independence Day are observed with active public participation. Every citizen should plant at least one sapling wherever they are whether in offices, schools, societies, parks, balconies, or gardens and be a part of this green movement.

Our Goal:

To make every citizen of Uttarakhand environmentally aware by the year 2035 and to establish our state's identity as a Green State.

Let us all come together to turn this campaign into a mass movement and make the land of Uttarakhand greener and more prosperous.

Our Roadmap



For Schools and Colleges

We will approach schools and colleges of Uttarakhand, share our mission, drive details, and environmental benefits and distribute digital flyers and posters for display on notice boards. We will conduct interactive sessions on environmental conservation. Encourage participation through eco clubs and student organizations and also and also invite institutions to host plantation drives within their campuses or to donate us plants or help us in our plantation drive. We will coordinate sapling delivery and provide guidance for planting, involve student and teacher volunteers in the planting activity. Also, we will recognize active participants with certificates or appreciation letters.

Our appeal to the Uttarakhand Government

We will humbly propose to the Honorable Chief Minister of Uttarakhand that the Government of Uttarakhand reimagine "**Harela**" on **July 16th** not as a day off, but as a **Statewide Environmental Action Day**, much like how **Independence Day** or **Republic Day** are observed with **flag hoisting ceremonies and active public participation**. On this day, every citizen should be encouraged to plant at least one sapling, whether in their offices, schools, societies, parks, or even balconies and gardens. The goal is to make environmental responsibility a shared tradition, not just a symbolic one.

For Government Offices

We propose that every employee of the department plant at least one sapling within its premises and ensure proper care and maintenance of the plantations throughout the year. Offices can establish a visible "Green Corner" to reflect their commitment and organize awareness sessions to engage employees. Such proactive efforts will not only enhance public spaces but also inspire citizens, institutions, and private organizations to follow suit, fostering a culture of collective environmental stewardship.
